<b>Summary of the grant:</b>	<p>Through institutional grant support, the Group for Legal and Political Studies (GLPS) aims to strengthen its capacities in the field of the rule of law by continuing the development and advancement of its flagship initiative—the Rule of Law Performance Index in Kosovo (RoLPIK), a data-driven monitoring instrument established in 2015. This support seeks to contribute to the promotion of a more transparent, accountable, and citizen-oriented rule of law system.</p> <p>During the implementation of the grant, GLPS will continue publishing regular editions of RoLPIK and will launch the “Rule of Law Observer” Magazine, which will serve as a platform for analysis, reflections, and discussions on developments in the field of the rule of law in Kosovo. In addition, the organization will implement capacity-building activities for local civil society organizations by transferring knowledge</p>



	<p>and monitoring and advocacy practices from existing instruments such as CorrWatch, Justice Today, and Just React, with the aim of expanding citizen-driven oversight also at the municipal level.</p> <p>Through this institutional support, GLPS seeks to further consolidate its role as an independent and leading think tank in Kosovo, strengthening the connection between citizens, civil society, and public institutions.</p>
