Target groups:	Students, journalists and young jurists (lawyers), involving marginalized groups in regards to gender and ethnicity.

Target Area:	The activities will take place in Pristina but with the involvement of journalists from other regions of Kosovo as well.
Overall Objective:	Empowerment of journalists and young jurists in Kosovo by increasing their capacities through different trainings including the importance of ethics and righteous media reporting and exchange of experiences. In addition, young students, journalists and lawyers will be informed on the legal consequences of incorrect and biased reporting.
Activities:	 Provision of 7 trainings for young journalists and jurists, journalistic ethics and legal consequences of improper reporting; Provision of legal assistance to enable access on public documents relevant to media; Distribution of 15 scholarships to students of the faculties of journalism and law for joint research; Editing and publishing of 15 researches conducted in cooperation with students that have obtained scholarships; Production of 2 television debates through TV programs "Life in Kosovo" and "Justice in Kosovo" on the topic of journalists' security and accurate and impartial reporting; Production of five long articles in the Kryp-o-meter (Truth-o-meter) on information accuracy.
Expected Results:	 Increasing capacities of young students of the faculty of journalism and law on righteous media reporting, preparation of requests for access on public documents and consequences of inaccurate reporting; Increasing the awareness and enhancing public debate on righteous journalist reporting and safety of journalists.
