Activities:	 Assessment of the current security situation in 5 secondary schools in South Mitrovica. This activity will be followed by a press conference on the opening of the "Safety at School" project. Presentation of "Stop and Act Show" performance in schools and 25 lessons / lectures on prevention of violence and security in schools. 700 students, 50 teachers and 50 parents benefit from the lectures. Organizing races in essays on prevention of violence in schools and increasing safety in schools. Design, design and distribution of promotional materials for preventing violence and increasing security in schools. Organization of two public debates / hearings with relevant stakeholders to discuss the issue of school security and prevention of violence, drawing up recommendations and advocating for decision-makers on these issues. Awareness campaign in electronic media on radio stations in Mitrovica, with the message to increase security in schools and to prevent violence between students inside and outside the school. Final conference of the project, submission of recommendations and submission to the decision-maker.
Results:	 Strengthen and Mobilize "Internal Defense Network" of Student, Pupils Council, School Director, School Board Council, Parents, Parents Council), in the 5 secondary schools in South Mitrovica. Increased participation in decision-making processes at local level by increasing cross-sectoral cooperation for greater security in schools. The Directorate of Education is supplied with recommendations and suggestions arising from the activities of the "School Security" project, which they consider and forward to the Ministry of Education. Social awareness is enhanced to prevent violence and increase school security through: public debates, conferences, report publishing, media campaigns, promotional materials, and essay
