Target Area:	The project cover two municipalities, municipality of Prizren and the municipality of Suhareka.
Overall Objective:	Improving local employment policies and creating opportunities for a better access to employment through vocational training, work practices to local business towards permanent employment and self-employment opportunities for youth unemployed and those ready for the labour market.
Activities:	Activity 1: Training and professional development through establishing of an innovative business for self-employment, Activity 2 Improvement of soft skills (preparation of personal CV, job interview, job search etc.), Activity 3 Professional training for job market preparation such as computer courses for Office package, website etc, Activity 4 Work practices at local business for 3 months, Activity 5 Publishing of the leaflet on "Rights at work and employment",
Expected Results:	Direct beneficiaries will be about 74 beneficiaries in training, vocational training and work practices, ages 15-29, males and females include young people with disabilities and minorities in the municipalities where the project is located.
	-The direct beneficiaries of work practices in local business, will benefit about 14 interns from both genders, ages 18 - 29 years for 3 months of paid work in sectors: tailoring, vegetable and flower production in greenhouses, mechanical, electrical, water supply, carpentry and tannery, will benefit about 7 businesses one of them in agriculture sector.
	 Beneficiaries in vocational training and improving skills will benefit: 25 beneficiaries from both genders, ages 18-29, will be trained in how to establish a business, how to prepare a business plan and how to manage a business. improving soft skills, will benefit 25 young people from both genders age 15 - 29 years, will be trained on how to prepare a personal CV, knowledge of employment law and employment contracts, job interview, job search etc), 10 young people both genders age 15 - 29 years will be trained in website design and maintenance, professional use of Microsoft office packs etc.
	- By publishing leaflet, unemployed youth who are not registered in the employment office will be notified about the opportunities they will receive if they are registered as jobseeker.
