There will also be participants from the Roma, Ashkalinj and Egyptian communities as well as Serb or Bosnian communities - representing NGO's and youth workers.

Overall Objective:	The overall objective of "Youth Workers for Young People" is to improve the quality of youth work and non-formal education through capacity building of 25 youth NGO staff in Kosovo focusing on building their core competencies and competencies with a focus on in developing four dimensions: attitudes, knowledge, skills, and behaviours
Activities:	Zero phase / pre-training sessions; EXPLORING YOUTH WORK - First three (3) day / residency training with 25 youth staff + 2 international coaches + 3 support staff (3 days); EXPLORING TOOLS - Youth workers selected for the project - exploring tools after training courses; Young Youth Work Providers for Young People - Second residency training (25 Partnerships and Action Planning) 25 participants (2 youth workers), 2 international trainers and 3 support staff).
Expected Results:	Building the capacity of youth workers to be reactive to the needs of young people and adapt their practices and methods in line with youth quality work and non-formal education principles through YEU international manuals and trainers; Building the competence of youth workers in quality youth work and its implementation: changing the lives of young people requires the development of human resources, broadening their perspective, building competences and the appetite to never stop. learning and

exploration;

Empower, motivate and train target and project organizations, finding and disseminate common tools to form a targeted action plan of targeted organizations for better access to youth. To disseminate the principles and practices of youth work quality by raising awareness of youth work and supporting their implementation at local and national level;

To draft strengths and weaknesses, the impact and capabilities of youth work and non-formal education in member / partner organizations and create a common basis for understanding our best practices and models.
