Summary of the grant:	The goal of TOKA is to empower young people who come from disadvantaged areas to become agents of positive change – both today and in the future. Through this grant TOKA will achieve these specific results: Empowering children and youth – through non-formal education programs, volunteerism and wider democratic participation. Building the capacities of youth leaders – through training and mentoring, volunteer leaders will provide leadership and support to youth in their communities. Improving Kosovo's ecosystem for youth education, volunteering and broader democratic participation – through advocacy and partnership with institutions for better laws, policies and practices. Mobilizing non-governmental actors (eg private sector and diaspora) to increase their contribution to a more sustainable ecosystem for youth education, volunteering and democratic participation. Improving the regional ecosystem for youth education, volunteering and wider democratic participation – through advocacy and joint initiatives with progressive-minded CSOs in the region and Europe. Whereas the main activities are: Engaging young individuals with institutions and expanding active citizenship among young individuals at local and central levels. Organizing the Annual "Volunteer of the Year" Award and Conference; Organizing annual roundtable discussions with relevant institutions to address priorities and obstacles for participation and greater civic activism of young people; Securing

annual financial support and contribution to youth activism from institutions and businesses; Promoting regional cooperation and solidarity through joint regional initiatives, including the Regional Educational Volunteering Award. The principle of our geographical outreach is simple - we meet our target groups where they are. Our beneficiaries come from more than 15 municipalities across Kosovo – and there's where we support them. The main change expected at the end of the grant period is to have a broader and more sustainable ecosystem for the participation and active citizenship of young individuals in Kosovo.
